ATANAS PAPARIZOV INFORMED THE PES GROUP FOR THE PROPOSALS FOR CHANGES IN THE BULGARIAN GOVERNMENT

During the EP plenary session in Strasbourg the head of the Bulgarian Socialist Delegation in the EP - Atanas Paparizov, informed the Group of the Party of European Socialists (PES) about the proposals for changes in the Bulgarian government.
