

ELMAR BROK APPOINTED MEMBER OF EU REFORM TREATY CONFERENCE

The EPP-ED Group in the European Parliament has appointed Elmar Brok MEP as its member for the intergovernmental conference which will work out the details of the EU reform treaty.

The European Parliament is expected to send three Members to the intergovernmental conference, to help draft the new reform treaty which EU heads of government agreed on at the European Council on June 22 and 23.
